## Remote Workforce Options

### Virtual Private Network

Remote computer creates a pinhole connection into business network and all business resources are available to it. Remote computer appears as if it were on-premise.




### Remote Desktop

Desktop at work is streamed to a remote computer. All tasks are executed on-premise. No data leaves or enters business network.




