## **Situation**

IMEC collaborated with Fuyao Glass Illinois to make sure that they were prepared beyond the initial testing level required - and go even further. When the company achieved accreditation to the ISO/IEC 17025 standard in February 2023, they were elated to learn from the accreditation body that their system was more robust and effective than 90% of the systems he had audited!
